

General information about Heckrodt Wetland Reserve Girl Scout Clinics and programs.

All programs require pre-registration and prepayment. Fee for each program is \$8/scout, unless otherwise noted. Siblings over age 6 may attend for \$8/child, but they must be registered in advance. There are no refunds for cancellations, however substitutes are permitted.

Girls must be accompanied by leaders and/or parent chaperones. There is never a charge for these adults. Adult: scout ratios required by the Girls Scouts are required for all clinics.

Girls should arrive dressed for the weather and ready to participate in fun, hands-on learning. Programs involve a combination of learn-at-your-pace stations and educator-lead activities. Programs will run regardless of the weather, with adaptations made to accommodate outdoor conditions.

Registering for any Heckrodt Wetland Reserve Girl Scout Clinic implies consent for HWR use of any photographs taken during the clinic. Leaders/ parents must advise the clinic leader at least one week before the clinic if there are exceptions.
