

All programs **require pre-registration and prepayment**. Fee for each program is \$8 per scout, unless otherwise noted. Siblings over age 5 may attend for \$8/child, but they must be registered in advance. These programs are not appropriate for children under age 4, and they should not attend. There are no refunds for cancellations, however substitutes are permitted.

Scouts must be accompanied by leaders and/or parent chaperones. There is no charge for these adults. Adult/scout ratios required by the BSA are required for all clinics. Tiger Cub programs include scout plus adult partner, as outlined by the BSA. Maximum total attendance numbers for each program are established by each program on the space available. These numbers vary with each program.

Note: Clinics have limited space. Only adults assisting scouts with the clinic should attend.

Heckrodt Wetland Reserve Scouting Programs include an outdoor segment. Scouts should arrive dressed for the weather and ready to participate in fun, hands-on learning. Programs involve a combination of learn-at-your-pace stations and educator-lead activities. Programs will run regardless of the weather, with adaptations made to accommodate outdoor conditions if necessary.

Registering for any Heckrodt Wetland Reserve Scout Program implies consent for use of any photographs taken during the clinic. Leaders/parents must advise the clinic leader at least one week before the clinic if there are exceptions.

Heckrodt Wetland Reserve includes 76 acres of forested wetland, wetland meadow, open water, and upland field communities. The wheelchair & stroller-friendly 3+ mile trail system includes a boardwalk that allows access to the wetland without getting wet feet! The Reserve is home to a variety of mammals, birds, insects, reptiles, and amphibians. Facilities include a nature center with indoor living wetland and live reptiles, amphibians, and fish, as well as mounted specimens of Wisconsin mammals and bird species. Educational programs are provided for schools, daycares, special focus groups (pre-school, grade school, scouts, and senior citizens), and the general public. Our goal is to provide visitor education while fostering an ethic of environmental stewardship in a fun, hands-on atmosphere.

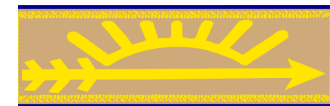
